# Potential Job Openings for Low Income Residents

Within the next few months, the Town of Boone will be constructing a water tank, funded by a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). If construction jobs become available as a result of this project, preference in hiring will be given to public housing residents or low or very low income workers who can also meet basic worker qualifications and reside in the town of Boone (known as “Section 3 residents” in CDBG terminology)<sup>1</sup>.

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<sup>1</sup> Section 3 is a provision of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968. The purpose of Section 3 is to ensure that preference for employment, training and contracting opportunities generated from the expenditure of certain HUD funds is directed to local low-and very low-income persons, particularly those who receive federal housing assistance, and businesses that are owned by or substantially employ such persons.
