


Grease is a big problem!

Like cholesterol in arteries, grease restricts the flow of wastewater by accumulating on the walls of the sewer pipes.



When the flow becomes too restricted, wastewater backs up and overflows the system. Grease buildup is both a human health and environmental hazard!

Grease Prevention Program


Don't Wash Grease, or Your Money, Down the Drain

Your Town spends a lot of your tax money every year clearing blockages and cleaning up sewer overflows caused by grease. To help reduce this problem, the Town has established the Grease Prevention Program.



Each residential household and Food Service Establishment can help by following the *Prevention and Good Housekeeping* suggestions below. Food Service Establishments are also required to participate in the Grease Prevention-Trap Inspection Program. See the next panel for more details.

Prevention and Good Housekeeping



Deposit liquid & solid food scraps in the trash, not the disposal



Do not pour hot grease down drains; let cooking grease & oils cool, & then dispose of them in the garbage



Dry-wipe utensils, dishes, and other surfaces prior to washing



Educate your family on proper grease disposal

Grease Prevention-Trap Inspection Program:

Required participation for the following Food Service Establishments (FSE)

Restaurants;
Lunch counters;
Cafeterias;
Bars and clubs;
Hotel/Lounge kitchens or bars;
School kitchens;
Nursing home kitchens;
Day Care Center kitchens;
Hospital kitchens;
Other establishments where grease may be introduced into the collection system
