

# Rules for Street Vending In Downtown Boone



## Vendor Spaces/ Permit Information

- To vend in downtown Boone, on town-owned public property and town-maintained public rights of way, you **must have and display at all times an approved and unexpired permit from the Town of Boone.**
- Street vending will only be allowed in the spaces identified by the town manager in front of the Downtown Boone Post Office located at 680 W. King Street Boone, NC 28607.
- Vendors make only use one vending space as indicated in the **Post Office Space Report (PDF)**.
- Vendors will not block the bench located in this area or place any items on the bench or any retaining walls.
- Vendors will not disturb the mulched area or store anything in landscaped areas.
- Vendors may use a properly anchored single-pole umbrella, that does not interfere with pedestrian traffic or pose any other public safety concerns. Tents and canopies will not be allowed.
- Vendors will need to pick up, remove and dispose of all trash or refuse remaining from the activities of the vendor or vendor's customers.



## Prohibited Merchandise/ Vending Practices

- Vendors may **not** sell second-hand (used) clothing, personal effects, home furnishings, or similar used merchandise.
- Vendors may **not** cook food using a heat source (e.g. boil, roast, broil, bake or fry) at a vending stand.
- Vendors will **not** be allowed to sound or permit the sounding of any device which produces a loud and raucous noise or engage in hawking or harassment to gain attention.
- Vendors will **not** be allowed to solicit or conduct business with persons in motor vehicles.
- Vendors may **not** have any advertising other than the posting of prices, the names of goods, and the name and contact information of the vendor.
- Vendors will need to pick up, remove and dispose of all trash or refuse remaining from the activities of the vendor or vendor's customers.
